

A WORD FROM PASTOR RALPH

Hey church family, I wanted you to rejoice with us. Last month, we hit the \$3 million mark in our building fund. It took us 10 years to save this amount. Our desire is to have at least half the funds needed to build our next major facility. We have conceptual drawings of an educational building, chapel & office but we are also considering whether the greater need is a next generational building (preschool, children, middle and high school) with a gymnatorium. If we go with option two, we will turn the current preschool and children's building into adult small group space. We will continue to pray, plan and save so we will be prepared when we get the green light from God. Thank you for your faithful generosity.

Update on the Plowman's adoption (goal: to adopt a special needs child from India). Thus far, we are just a few dollars shy of \$4,000 (matching grant up to \$6,500). This will be a four-week study starting April 11th and ending May 2nd at 9:30 am. The cost is free.


